

Remote Desktop for Windows 10

 On the computer being used to connect to the remote computer, launch the **Remote Desktop Connection** by clicking on the windows logo on the bottom left of screen

Type **Remote** then select the **Remote Desktop Connection app.**

- 2. Enter the name of the remote computer into the **Computer** field. There are 3 values that can be entered for the computer name:
 - a. Computer name
 - b. Computername.win.uthscsa.edu or
 - c. IP (internet protocol) address 129.111.xxx.xxx For various reasons, one or more of the above methods may not work. In the event that one connection method is not working, try one of the other naming conventions. For off campus users double check that VPN is running before you attempt to connect to the remote computer.
